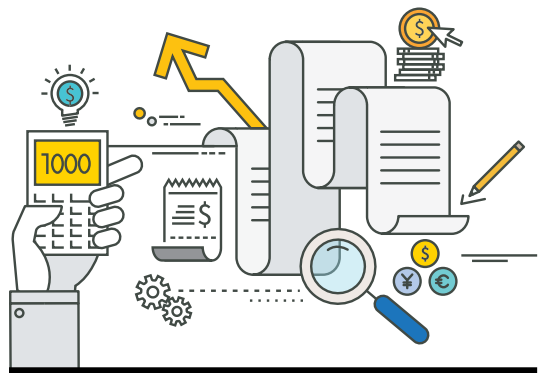

Interfaith is proud to offer San Diego County residents a safe place to recover from addiction and co-occurring disorders. A 14-day withdrawal management (detox) program and residential or outpatient treatment programs provide a continuum of care for long-term success.
