Interfaith Poway Satellite Location Opens

- Open Monday, Thursday, and Friday 2:00 – 5:00pm at Mt. Olive Lutheran Church
- Basic needs: Emergency Food Pantry, ID - Birth Certificate – Driver's License assistance, clothing vouchers, transportation assistance, access to Cal-Fresh and Medi-Cal, prescription assistance, resource information for services outside Interfaith (such as domestic healthcare options)
- Ongoing case management for low-income individuals & families, with a focus on employment
- Motel vouchers (resources willing)
- Move-in assistance for certain homeless individuals and families
- Connections to all [Interfaith Community Services](#) programs, including Housing, Employment, Drug & Alcohol Treatment, Behavioral Health Counseling, and Homeless Court

How can you help?

- **The following types of support are needed:**
- **Monetary Donations:** to cover staffing, materials, travel expenses, and direct client assistance to meet emergency financial needs and to support with housing and transportation.
- **In-Kind Donations:** Service center office supplies and materials, non-perishable food & personal hygiene items. Trinity of San Diego (offers food distribution MWF from 3 to 6 PM).
- **Volunteers and advertising:** Client Intake Volunteers and handout information on services, days and hours to all those in need.

CHANGES IN REGIONAL HOMELESS PROGRAMS

- Coordinated Assessment and Housing Placement (CAHP) system Interfaith helped launch in North County in 2015 now serving the entire region
 - Staff of 2 has grown to 10, housed at the Regional Taskforce on Homelessness
- CAHP has assessed more than 12,000 individuals and families, seeks to connect them to the best permanent housing resource
- Long ways to go for CAHP, but progress is being made to more efficiently deploy resources in the most client-centered way throughout all of San Diego County

Evolution of CAHP in San Diego

- June 2014: Downtown Launch
- January 2015: North County Launch
- January 2016: Adopted by Regional Continuum of Care
- August 2016: East Bay & South County Launch
- November 2016: CAHP Staff & Systems Fully Centralized within Regional Continuum of Care Infrastructure Organization

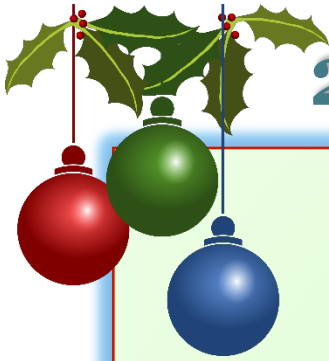
