You can provide children in need with tools to enhance their success both in and out of the classroom by filling backpacks with school supplies and donating them to Interfaith.

Impact:

- Enhance a child's academic experience
- Remind children that our community cares about their well-being and educational success
- Allow parents to focus on other goals, such as obtaining employment and housing

Volunteers are responsible for providing NEW backpacks with a majority of the following NEW items inside:

- Spiral notebooks and two-pocket folders
- Pens, pencils, and markers
- Books, flash cards, or additional educational materials
- Calendars or planners (for middle and high school students)
- If desired, you may include an inspirational note or message in the backpack (please refrain from using religious or political messages)



Time Commitment:

- This can be either a one-time opportunity, or an ongoing commitment
- Length of the project varies depending on the number of volunteers and the number of backpacks being made
